
That together you may unanimously with united hearts & one voice, praise & glorify the God & Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.


Sing a Hallelujah!

So give praise & thanks to the Lord of Hosts, for the Lord is good. Can you sing a Hallelujah that God is rebuilding the desolate place in your heart.




Blessed, praised & extolled & thanked be the Lord, the God of Israel, because He has come & brought deliverance & redemption to His

When we tear down the veil of daunted unbelief and step into the beauty of holiness, we find that we can worship God in a way beyond any Hallelujah ever heard.




