*Day 1*

*Psalm 40:3*

*And He has put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to our God. Many shall see and fear (revere & worship) and put their trust and confident reliance in the Lord.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*Grab hold of God's hand & let Him help you out of this daunter pit & then raise your hands & sing a hallelujah! Many will see what He has done in your life & be amazed. They will put their trust in the Lord, because you raised a Hallelujah!*

*Day 2*  
*Revelation 19:1*



*After this I heard what sounded like a mighty shout of a great crowd in heaven, exclaiming, Hallelujah, praise the Lord! Salvation & glory, splendor & majesty & power, dominion & authority belong our God.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*Day 3*

*Revelation 19:6-7*

## Day 5

### Matthew 8:2-4

*And behold, a leper came up to Him, & prostrating himself, worshiped Him, saying, Lord if You are willing, You are able to cleanse me by curing me. And He reached out His hand and touched him, saying I am willing; be cleansed by being cured. And instantly his leprosy was cured and cleansed. And Jesus said to him, See that you tell nothing about this to anyone; but go, show yourself to the priest and present the offering that Moses commanded, for a testimony (to your healing) and as an evidence to the people.*

*Can we sing a Hallelujah today  
for the fact that we are chosen,  
His own special people and that  
we can proclaim His praises?*



*Day 9*

*Psalm 51:8*

*Make me to hear joy  
and gladness and be  
satisfied; let the bones  
which You have broken  
rejoice.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*Our tender physician restores these  
bones and after the healing takes place  
we rejoice again. Will you let those  
bones that He broke rejoice today, so  
your healing will be complete?*

*Day 10*  
*Colossians 3:17*



*And whatever you do, no matter what it is, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus & in dependence upon His Person, giving praise to God the Father through Him.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*It is so hard to be upset when you are praising God, even for the thankless tasks in our lives. So praise Him in the little things and do them for His glory and then a beautiful Hallelujah will follow.*



*Day 11*

*Isaiah 42:10*

heard in the heathen world.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*The world needs to hear the  
praises of Undaunted women like  
never before, can you find a new  
hallelujah to rise out of your hurt  
and daunted years?*

*Day 12*  
*Proverbs 31:25*



*Strength & dignity are her clothing & her position is strong & secure; she rejoices over the future, the latter day or time to come, knowing that she & her family are in readiness for it!*

Day 14  
Psalm 104:33

are in stop you from worshipping  
with your all!



*Day 15*

*Isaiah 42:8*

graven images.*

find what we are worshipping.*

*Can you find a pure Hallelujah  
today that gives only God the glo-  
ry and that He gets all of you in?*

*Day 16*

*1 Chronicles 16:25*



*For great is the Lord  
and greatly to be  
praised; He also is to be  
reverently feared above  
all so-called gods.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*We need to do regular health checks  
to make sure God is on the throne  
of our hearts. So sing a Hallelujah  
to Him today because He is great  
and greatly to be praised!*



*Day 17*

*Jeremiah 33:11*

*There shall be heard again the voice of joy & the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom & the voice of the bride, the voices of those who sing as they bring sacrifices of thanksgiving into the house of the Lord, Give praise & thanks to the Lord of hosts, for the Lord is good; for His mercy & kindness & steadfast love endure forever! For I will cause the captivity of the land to be reversed & return to be as it was at first, says the Lord.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*So give praise & thanks to the Lord of Hosts, for the Lord is good. Can you sing a Hallelujah that God is rebuilding the desolate place in your heart.*

*Day 18*  
*Luke 1:68*



*Blessed, praised & extolled  
& thanked be the Lord, the  
God of Israel, because He  
has come & brought deliv-  
erance & redemption to His  
people.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*When we let the light of Christ shine  
in our hearts, the dark shadows that  
Daunters cast over our calling disap-  
pears and we, like Zechariah, can sing  
a Hallelujah to God for His deliverance.*



*Day 19*

*Psalms 113:3*

*From the rising of the sun to the going down of it and from east to west, the name of the Lord is to be praised!*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*Today, sing a hallelujah in your heart all day that will shine through you and praise the name of the Lord.*

Day 20  
Psalm 96:1



O sing to the Lord

that will revive your heart  
and restore your spirit.



*Day 21*

*Psalm 100:2*

*Serve the Lord with  
gladness! Come be-

with singing!*

*Come before Him today  
with a song of praise on  
your lips, let your Hallelujah  
be filled with gladness.*



*Day 22*  
*1 Samuel 2:1*



*Hannah prayed, and said, My heart exults and triumphs in the Lord; my horn (my strength) is lifted in the Lord. My mouth is no longer silent, for it is opened wide over my enemies, because I rejoice in Your salvation.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*Will you break your silence and sing a Hallelujah to God for the victory He has given you in the barren place in your life? Can you do it even if a Daunter still stands there taunting you?*



*Day 23*

*Hebrews 13:15*

*Through Him, therefore, let us constantly and at all times offer up to God a sacrifice of praise, which is the fruit of lips that thankfully acknowledge and confess and glorify His name.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*When our hearts are focused on glorifying God then the fruit of that will show & be seen by all. Can you surrender your worry & stress today & sing a hallelujah that acknowledges & glorifies God's name?*

*Day 24*  
*Acts 16:25-26*



*But about midnight, as Paul & Silas were praying & singing hymns of praise to God, & the other prisoners were listening to them, suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the very foundations of the prison were shaken; and at once all the doors were opened & everyone's shackles were unfastened.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*What we do in our prisons can have such a profound effect not only on our lives but on the lives of those around us. Will you lift your hands despite the shackles of captivity & sing a hallelujah that will make Heaven move?*



*Day 25*

*Psalm 9:1*

*I will praise You, O Lord,  
with my whole heart; I will  
show forth, recount and  
tell aloud, all Your marvelous  
works and wonderful deeds!*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*There will be times when your testi-  
mony will give someone else hope and  
courage against their Daunter. Can  
you sing aloud a Hallelujah for the  
marvelous works He has done in your  
life?*

Day 26

1 Chronicles 16:29



Ascribe to the Lord the glory due His name. Bring an offering and come before Him; worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness and in holy array.

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

When we tear down the veil of daunted unbelief and step into the beauty of holiness, we find that we can worship God in a way beyond any Hallelujah ever heard.



*Day 27*

*John 4:23-24*

*A time will come, however, indeed it is already here, when the true, genuine, worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth (reality); for the Father is seeking just such people as these as His worshipers. God is a Spirit, a spiritual Being and those who worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth, reality.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*



*When we find ourselves in this place, we can sing a Hallelujah not based on our emotions or our mood or our circumstances but simply because God is good & His steadfast love for us endures forever.*

*Day 28*  
*Romans 14:11*



*For it is written, As I live,  
says the Lord, every knee  
shall bow to Me, & every  
tongue shall confess to God,  
acknowledge Him to His hon-  
or and to His praise.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*Jesus said you are to be envied  
because you believe in Him now,  
because you praise Him now.  
Sing a Hallelujah today that  
gives Him honor.*



*Day 29*

*Matthew 26:10*

*But Jesus, fully aware of this, said to them, Why do you bother the woman? She has done a noble, praiseworthy and beautiful thing to Me.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*Can you take that thing that God has asked you to pour out in service to Jesus and give Him your most precious Hallelujah today?*



*Day 30*  
*Exodus 15:2*



*The Lord is my strength &  
my song, and He has become  
my Salvation; this is my God,  
and I will praise Him, my  
father's God, and I will exalt  
Him.*

*Sing a Hallelujah!*

*Like the Israelities, can you stand on  
the other side of your storm watch-  
ing your Daunter captor destroyed by  
the Daunter you thought was blocking  
your path and sing a Hallelujah?*
